SNOW REMOVAL VENDOR UPDATE (Video time: 00:34:14)

Snake River Excavation has been selected as the district's plowing vendor for the 24/25 season. Chair Harland will sign the contract following this meeting.

The meter loan 25% forgiveness has been applied to the loan. The first annual payment is due November 15th. The district is waiting for final loan documents to be provided.
